

/gcreate - Create Worlds

Create worlds

Creating worlds is one of the main functions of GWorld. The command is more powerful than it appears at first glance.

The command in detail

```
/gcreate <Name> [Environment] [Seed] [Generator]
```

Parameters explained

1. **Name (required):** The name of the world. This is also used as the folder name.
 - *Allowed:* Letters, numbers, underscores, hyphens.
 - *Not allowed:* spaces, special characters.
2. **Environment (required):** Determines whether it is an overworld, nether, or end.
 - NORMAL (default world)
 - NETHER
 - THE_END
3. **Seed (Optional):** The starting value for world generation.
 - Omit the argument if there is no generator.
 - Example: TerraformGenerator, PlotSquared

To use a generator, you must have the corresponding plugin installed!

Examples

1. Standard Survival World

Simply create a normal world:

```
/gcreate MyWorld NORMAL
```

2. World with generator

Creating a world with a generator:

```
/gcreate MyWorld NORMAL TerraformGenerator
```

3. World with generator and seed

Create a world with a generator and seed:

```
/gcreate MyWorld NORMAL 12345678 TerraformGenerator
```

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
